I'm pleased to recommend Ann Schneider (three-term Town Council Member of Oak Ridge, NC) for service as Second Vice President for the District 9 seat.


Over the past two years, Ann has been a steady, thoughtful, and transparent leader on the League Board as an At Large member and now as a Presidential Appointee.
